Sha-kai T. Springer was born on November 10, 1993 to Tameka Fordham & Leanthony Springer. Sha-kai is the oldest of three children. Sha-kai is a 15 year old junior and will begin her first year at Edsel Ford High School in Dearborn, MI. She previously attended Communications & Media Arts High School in Detroit, Michigan where she maintained a 3.0 GPA. Some of her other accomplishments include first in the state of Michigan in the 9-10 year old girls sparring in 2003, the 2002 Final Rumble 1st place 7-8 year old sparring, 2002 WISK Battle of the Minds 1st place 7-8 year old sparring, 2006 Spirit of Detroit Karate Championships 1st place 11-12 year old girls sparring and 2007 Michigan Sport Karate Open 1st place 13-14 year old girls sparring. She is still trying for her fist title as a black belt.

Sha-kai also participates in basketball and softball. She began playing basketball and softball when she was 7 years old with the Lady Tigers 10 & under PAL League. Sha-kai played for the basketball and softball teams at CMA High School during her first two years of high school.
